Employment Contracts (chiropractic assistants and office staff)

There are a few options for employment contracts:

1. Google "employment contracts" and use what is populated

<u>Pros</u>: it costs you nothing

Cons: not advised, it could cost you everything in the event of a dispute

2. Engage services of an "online attorney" such as Legal Zoom, Rocket Lawyer, etc....

<u>Pros:</u> this is an actual attorney that creates a template contract at a low cost Cons: these are general contracts not specific to your specific situation

 - *It is far cheaper to have a contract in place before issues arise than it is to pay the aftermath of a costly dispute
