

Hello, in regards to Back To Chiropractic hosting live seminars, here's what's happening:

As of January 7th, 2026, Live video conferencing (Zoom) was approved by the California Board of Chiropractic Examiners as an **OPTION** to fulfill the 12-hour live in person CE requirement.

Please know we already have a complete schedule through June, with 12 dates per month that include: Ethics, Billing, Hx & Ex, Tech, Labs, Neurology, Nutrition, Pediatrics, Radiology & Wellness. Many of these were never available in your area.

The response has been overwhelmingly positive and we had to cancel four seminars in January due to lack of attendance, (which has never happened before).

My understanding is the ICAC immediately cancelled all their Live In-Person dates as well.

Zoom is such a convenient choice, making CE seminars easier and more efficient than ever.

Taking CE from the comfort of your own home and avoiding traveling time and expenses is a huge benefit. You are not tied to a chair and a computer screen, if you set it up to run through your Smart TV, this allows you to move around in your living room! Also Zoom actually provides an increased opportunity to interact during a CE seminar, (using the chat option, multiple DCs can speak at once).

I know a few are uncomfortable with the technology, but I encourage you to give it a chance.

What we may be losing is that person-to-person interaction. Our plan is to schedule a limited number of live-in-person events and see if there is still a demand.
