

Anti-Bias Training

Objectives: Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to:

1. Understand and increase QME awareness of perceived and/or non-perceived biases, or discrimination that may impact the examination and/or related QME report(s).
2. Review different types of gender biases with QME examinations/reports.
3. Consider how QME biases can affect the overall outcome of the report, over/under impairment rating, rationale, apportionment, causation.
4. Review implicit (unconscious) bias that a QME may have.
5. Consider cultural biases.
6. Consider age biases.
7. Consider racial biases.
8. Consider religious biases.
9. Consider biases may be formed from a variety of media; childhood, parents, friends, movies, music.
10. Review confirmation bias.
