

Partnership Contracts (Multi-doctor offices)

There are a few options for partnership agreements or contracts:

1. Google “partnership agreements or contracts” and use what is populated
Pros: it costs you nothing
Cons: not advised, it could cost you everything in the event of a dispute
2. Engage services of an “online attorney” such as Legal Zoom, Rocket Lawyer, etc....
Pros: this is an actual attorney that creates a partnership contract at a low cost
Cons: these are nonspecific contracts that may not relate to your specific situation
3. Contact an attorney that concentrates in Chiropractic partnership contracts
(Recommended)
Pros:
 - *If there is a simple solution they will let you know
 - *You protect your assets that you have worked so hard to attain
 - *You get a tailor-made custom partnership agreement that suits your individual needs
 - *The call will cost you nothing and can save you headaches and money
 - *It is far cheaper to have a partnership agreement in place to define all the parties obligations and expectations than it is to pay the aftermath of a costly dispute

Cons:

*Partnership agreements are in-depth and initial costs are higher
