

# Professional Chiropractic Corporation

There are a few options in the formation of a Professional Corporation “P.C.”

1. Try to form it yourself contact the Secretary of State of California and the California Chiropractic Board.  
Pros: the costs are limited and you will learn what business law is  
Cons: paperwork must be filed in the right order and have the correct wording
2. Engage services of an “attorney” in your area or online  
Pros: takes the worry out of your hands all but assures that the process is done correctly  
Cons: the fees will add up quick
3. Contact an attorney that concentrates on Business Law for Chiropractors

  - \*The paperwork was filled out correctly, and yearly meetings are calendared
  - \*Reliable and diligent work completed for your P.C.
  - \*You protect your assets from a suit that you have worked so hard to attain
  - \*In some cases a tax advantage for a Corporation when filing an “S Corp.”
  - \*It saves you time, money  
Cons:
  - \*\$800.00 to the Franchise Tax Board every year
